3. Sustainable Development: Detail the meaning and importance of sustainable development, list major Earth Summits (like Agenda 21) and analyze the current status of development.
4. Social Issues: Choose a topic like gender issues, economic disparity, or communalism and analyze its impact on modern society.
5. Subject Worksheets / Chapter Revisions typically assign written Q&A to help you practice what you have learned:
  - a) History: Briefly define terms like Romanticism, Absolutist, or Allegory (e.g., Germania, Marianne, Bharat Mata).
  - b) Geography: Define renewable vs. non-renewable resources and suggest at least 6 measures to solve the problem of land degradation.
  - c) Economics: Compare Class 10 Development indicators (like Literacy Rates, Infant Mortality Rates, and Net Attendance Ratios) across different Indian states.
